

Night works

Banyo station



What?

Queensland Rail will undertake works on selected nights in May and early June 2024, as part of the Banyo station accessibility upgrade.

These night works are a continuation of the current program of Energex activities and include excavation, concrete pumping and footpath reinstatement works.

Over three nights, Monday 3 to Wednesday 5 June, platform raising activities, including the operation of a large crane, will also be undertaken.



When?

Night works from 8pm until 6am the next day on:

- **Sunday 19 to Thursday 23 May** (over five nights)
- **Sunday 26 to Thursday 30 May** (over five nights)
- **Monday 3 to Wednesday 5 June** (over three nights).



Where?

Electrical and associated civil works will continue in footpath areas in the vicinity of the level crossing on St Vincent's Road, Tufnell Road, Royal Parade and Royal Parade east.

Crane operation (in June) will be undertaken from private property, by prior arrangement with property owners.



Impacts



Operation of excavators, concrete pumping trucks, large cranes (June) and vehicles with flashing lights and reversing beepers



Construction noise: Electrical works, excavation, operation of concrete pumps, machinery and powered tools
