

# Extended working hours

## Banyo station



### What?

Queensland Rail's contractor will temporarily extend project working hours during September and October to facilitate planned concrete pours for the Banyo station accessibility upgrade.

We apologise for any inconvenience caused by these changed working arrangements.



### When?

Temporarily extended working hours **5am to 6:30pm** daily (Monday to Saturday) from **Wednesday 25 September** until **Friday 25 October 2024**.

After hours activities (nights, Sundays and public holidays) will be notified separately, prior to the commencement of works.



### Where?

Construction works, including concrete pours, throughout the Banyo station precinct, with activity on platforms, station carpark and upgrade work zones.

For safety, traffic management may support vehicles entering and exiting the work zones.



### Impacts



Movement of trucks, and vehicles with flashing lights and reversing beepers



Construction noise, operation of concrete pumping trucks, concrete vibrators, machinery and powered tools



Changed working hours - 5am to 6:30pm



Traffic controllers supporting activities



Lighting towers in use during dark hours
