PROJECT UPDATE - FEBRUARY 2025

The Banyo station accessibility upgrade is part of Queensland Rail's program to upgrade our stations to make them accessible for everyone.

About the project

Banyo station is being upgraded to make it more accessible, and easier for customers and the community to travel on our network.

The new, modern station will help people in wheelchairs, parents with prams and those travelling with luggage or who are injured, to access to our trains with ease.

Construction progress

The following works have been completed recently at Banyo:

- Continuing construction of station entrances and ticket office
- Continuing platform roofing and fencing throughout the precinct
- Continuing reinstatement of corridor fencing.

Upcoming works

Customers and the local community can expect to see the following activities in the coming weeks:

- Ticket office fit-out (ongoing)
- Lift commissioning
- Commissioning of new platform lighting
- Finishing works throughout the station precinct
- Construction of bicycle facilities
- Reinstatement works (ongoing)
- Landscaping throughout the precinct.

Construction impacts

During construction, localised impacts may include:

- station precinct closed for construction
- pedestrian detours and traffic changes for safety
- increased vehicle movements near works
- noise associated with construction activity
- station carpark closed (until project completion).

Regular working hours are **6am to 6pm, Monday to Saturday**. Prior notification will be provided for after hours activities (nights, Sundays or public holidays).

While the station is closed, an accessible shuttle bus route 316 operates between Banyo and Northgate stations to connect with rail services.
