PROJECT UPDATE – JANUARY 2025

The Banyo station accessibility upgrade is part of Queensland Rail's program to upgrade our stations to make them accessible for everyone.

About the project

Banyo station is being upgraded to make it more accessible, and easier for customers and the community to travel on our network.

The new, modern station will help people in wheelchairs, parents with prams and those travelling with luggage or who are injured, to access to our trains with ease.

Construction progress

Due to the weather events experienced late last year, we were unable to reopen the station to customers by the end of the year as planned.

We will update on a revised station reopening date in the near future.

The following works have been completed at Banyo:

- Installation of steel work platform and station structures
- Continuing platform works and concrete pours
- Continuing lift installation.

Upcoming works

Customers and the local community can expect to see the following activities in the coming weeks:

- Construction of station entrances, platforms and ticket office (ongoing)
- Fit-out of footbridge (ongoing)
- Finishing works platform shelter structures
- Reinstatement of corridor fencing.

Out of hours (night/weekend) works

 Around-the-clock works from 6am Saturday 1 until 10pm Sunday 2 February

Platform works, fencing, roofing, plumbing, operation of elevated work platforms, scissors lifts, lane closures with traffic management.

Construction impacts

During construction, localised impacts may include:

- pedestrian detours and traffic changes for safety
- station precinct closed for construction
- increased vehicle movements near works
- noise associated with construction activity
- closure of the station carpark (until project completion).

The project's regular working hours are 6am to 6pm, Monday to Saturday. Prior notification will be provided for after hours activities (nights, Sundays or public holidays).
