

Concrete activities - ongoing

Purchase Street, Banyo



What?

Queensland Rail's concrete pumping activities, involving a concrete pumping truck in Purchase Street, will continue throughout September.

These activities are part of the Banyo station accessibility upgrade and are a continuation of works recently notified, commencing with the concrete pour on Tuesday 10 September.



When?

Concrete pours are scheduled from **5:30am until 5pm** (day works with early starts) on:

- Wednesday 18 September 2024
- Friday 20 September 2024
- Friday 27 September 2024.

Dates and starting times may vary, depending on concrete availability.



Where?

Concrete pumping activities in Purchase Street (near the pedestrian path to the station footbridge which is currently closed). Concrete deliveries to site will be via local streets.

A lane closure with traffic management will be in operation on Purchase Street for safety. Please follow the direction of traffic controllers.

Access to private properties will be maintained. The pedestrian path along the footpath will be maintained.

Lane closure and traffic management
