Banyo station



What?

Queensland Rail will undertake electrical works on selected nights in June 2024, to coincide with the Banyo station accessibility upgrade.

These night works are a continuation of the current program of civil works undertaken in association with Energex activities and include electrical lighting and pole installation, excavation, concrete cutting (if required), concrete pumping and footpath reinstatement works.

We apologise for the late notice of these works - timing was determined by the associated Energex activities.



When?

Night works from 8pm until 6am the next day on:

- Monday 17 to Friday 21 June (over five nights)
- Monday 24 to Thursday 27 June (over four nights).

In addition, Energex works will continue nightly from Monday 10 June until the end of the month.



Where?

Electrical and associated civil works will continue in footpath areas in the vicinity of the level crossing on St Vincent's Road, Tufnell Road, Royal Parade and Royal Parade east.
