Concrete activities with early start



Near Purchase Street, Banyo



What?

Queensland Rail's contractor will undertake early morning concrete pumping activities as part of the Banyo station accessibility upgrade.

A concrete pumping truck will be situated in Purchase Street and within the rail corridor (off Railway Parade, behind the park/library carpark) to facilitate concrete works at the northern ends of both platforms.



When?

Activities will commence from 4am and continue throughout the day on:

- Wednesday 15 to Friday 17 January (up to three days)
- Thursday 23 to Saturday 25 January (up to three days).



Where?

Concrete activities in Purchase Street (near the pedestrian path to the station footbridge which is currently closed) and in the work zone (off Railway Parade) behind the Banyo library carpark.

Concrete deliveries to site will be via local streets.

A lane closure with traffic management will be in operation on Purchase Street for safety. Please follow the direction of traffic controllers.

Access to private properties will be maintained. The pedestrian path along the footpath will be maintained.
