Banyo station



What?

Queensland Rail's contractor will undertake early morning works as part of the Banyo station accessibility upgrade.

Activities on site will commence earlier than regular working hours to accommodate early morning concrete deliveries and pours.

Times are determined by concrete availability and we apologise for the late notice of these early morning activities.



When?

Early morning (out of hours) works:

- **Wednesday 9 October, from 3:30am**
- **Friday 18 October 2024, from 4:30am.**



Where?

Concrete pumping activities around the Banyo station precinct.

Concrete deliveries to site will be via local streets adjacent to the station precinct.

Traffic management will be in operation on local streets to assist safe access to the work site.



Impacts



Movement of concrete pumping trucks and vehicles with flashing lights and reversing beepers



Operation of concrete pumps, machinery and powered tools



Out of hours (early morning) works



Lane closures and traffic management



Lighting towers at night
