

Buranda station accessibility upgrade

Project update | November 2024

The Buranda station accessibility upgrade is part of Queensland Rail's ongoing investment to upgrade stations to make them accessible for everyone.



Project benefits

Buranda station is being upgraded to make it more accessible, and easier for customers and the community to travel on our network. The new, modern station will help people in wheelchairs, parents with prams and those travelling with luggage or who are injured to access our trains with ease.




Construction progress

Throughout October, there have been many oversized components delivered to site, which will make up the future station footbridge and stairs. These deliveries will continue into mid-November.

The project team is planning to install the new footbridge in November; an exciting project milestone that shows the upgrade at Buranda is taking shape and progressing well.

Works recently completed include:

- oversized footbridge segments delivered for on-site fit-out and installation in November
- installation of column steel cradle assemblies for footbridge
- \checkmark installation of copes on platform 1
- installation of copes and precast lift shaft on platform 2.

There are planned weekend closures of the inner city and Cleveland lines in November. These closures allow the project team to work around the clock and make good progress while trains are not running on the network. Weekend works will occur on Saturday 9 and Sunday 10, and Saturday 23 and Sunday 24 November 2024.

Some of the activities planned include:

- installation of footbridge segments on platform 1
- installation of stairs
- installation of platform awnings and steel
- painting of platform copes
- concrete slab pouring on platforms 1 and 2
- removal of existing overhead electrical masts.

All other works will generally take place between 6am and 6pm Monday to Saturday, unless notified. Every effort will be made to carry out these works with respect for our neighbours and customers.
