Why?

Queensland Rail will carry out night and weekend works as part of the Buranda station accessibility upgrade.

Night works are for the delivery of precast platform copes.

During the weekend works precast platform copes, platform 1 precast lift shaft and precast columns for the footbridge will be installed.



When?

Night works

- 7pm until 4am the next day on **Wednesday 29 May**.

Around the clock weekend works during a planned track closure:

- 6am Saturday 1 to 10pm Sunday 2 June
- 6am Saturday 15 to 10pm Sunday 16 June.



Where?

Works will be occurring within the Buranda station precinct and at the Queensland Rail owned properties at 13 Arne Street and between 36 Faversham Street, Buranda and the rail corridor.

There will be increased personnel, vehicle and truck movements on Arne Street and Gillingham Street to access the work site during this time.

Traffic control will be in place on Martin Street, Woolloongabba overnight on Wednesday 29 May to facilitate the delivery of precast platform cope units.

Lane closures and traffic management



Lighting towers at night
