Night works and road closure



Indooroopilly Bridge



What?

Queensland Rail is undertaking night works for the refurbishment and repainting of the Indooroopilly rail bridge.

For safety, Wharf Street will be closed each night under the bridges with a traffic diversion in operation. Wharf Street will be open each day between 6am and 6pm.



When?

Works will be carried out over three nights from Friday 21 to Sunday 23 February, each night from 6pm until 6am the next day.

Works have been scheduled after hours when rail traffic is reduced and freight traffic can be diverted.

During works, Wharf Street will be **closed each night at 6pm** and reopen to traffic each morning at 6am.



Where?

Bridge scaffolding and on-track activities will occur on Indooroopilly Bridge (steel rail bridge between the Walter Taylor road bridge and the Albert rail bridge).

Residents may notice an increase in project vehicles on surrounding roads.

Wharf Street will be closed overnight each night with a traffic diversion via Queenscroft Street, Halsbury Street, Chelmer Street East and Honour Avenue.

Motorists and pedestrians are requested to follow the instructions of traffic controllers, observe detour signage and drive to the changed traffic conditions.
