

# Weekend works and road closure

## Indooroopilly Bridge



### What?

Queensland Rail is undertaking weekend works for the refurbishment and repainting of the Indooroopilly rail bridge.

For safety, Wharf Street will be closed for the duration of the works with a traffic diversion in operation. The footpath directly adjacent to Wharf street will also be closed to pedestrians during this time.



### When?

Works will be carried out around the clock from **5am Saturday 22** through to **6pm Sunday 23 March**.

Works have been scheduled over the weekend when rail and freight traffic is reduced.

During works, Wharf Street and the adjacent footpath will be **closed from 5am Saturday morning** and will **reopen to traffic and pedestrians from 6pm Sunday evening**.



### Where?

Bridge scaffolding and on-track activities will occur on Indooroopilly Bridge (steel rail bridge between the Walter Taylor road bridge and the Albert rail bridge).

Residents may notice an increase in project vehicles on surrounding roads.

Wharf Street and the adjacent footpath will be closed throughout the entire weekend with a traffic diversion via Queenscroft Street, Halsbury Street, Chelmer Street East and Honour Avenue.

Motorists and pedestrians are requested to follow the instructions of traffic controllers, observe detour signage and drive to the changed traffic conditions.
