

# Lindum station accessibility upgrade



PROJECT UPDATE – JANUARY 2025

The Lindum station accessibility upgrade is part of Queensland Rail's program to upgrade our stations to make them accessible for everyone.

## About the project

Queensland Rail is pleased to advise that Lindum station is now open.

While trains are now stopping at the station, finishing touches and construction of the North Road carpark expansion are continuing into early 2025.

When completed, the station will be more accessible, and easier for customers and the community to travel on our network.

The upgraded station will help people in wheelchairs, parents with prams and those travelling with luggage or who are injured, to access our trains with ease.

## Construction progress

At Lindum, the following activities have recently been completed:

- Platform structures and station building
- Footbridge fit-out and lift commissioning
- Station reopening and recommenced train stopping patterns.

With the reopening of the station, the alternative shuttle bus between Lindum and Wynnum North has now ceased operations.

## Upcoming works

The following activities are scheduled in the coming weeks (weather and site conditions permitting):

- Reopening of pedestrian path to Iona College
- Sibley Road carpark and kiss 'n' ride works (ongoing)
- Finishing works throughout station precinct
- North Road carpark expansion and Eccles Street entry works.

## Construction impacts

During construction, localised impacts may include:

- North Road carpark closed
- reduced customer parking in Sibley Road carpark
- cross-corridor pedestrian access via level crossing local traffic management for safety
- increased vehicle movements near works
- noise associated with construction activity.

Normal working hours are **6am to 6pm, Monday to Saturday**. Prior notification will be provided for after hours activities (nights, Sundays or public holidays).

Thank you for your patience while we build you a better Lindum station.

## Out of hours/weekend works

- **Saturday 1 and Sunday 2 February, 6am to 6pm**  
Permanent power supply connection and lift commissioning. No station power - the station will remain open but without lifts, toilets or ticketing facilities.
