# Lindum station accessibility upgrade



#### PROJECT UPDATE – MAY 2024

The Lindum station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment to upgrade stations to make them accessible for everyone.

## About the project

Lindum station is being upgraded to make it more accessible, and easier for customers and the community to travel on our network.

The new, modern station will help people in wheelchairs, parents with prams and those travelling with luggage or who are injured, to access our trains with ease.

Lindum station is expected to reopen in the second half of 2024.

### **Project status**

The following works have been undertaken recently at Lindum station:

- Demolition of old timber footbridge
- **Piling** activities
- In-ground foundations (platforms, footbridge and lift shafts).

#### Upcoming works

Customers and the local community can expect to see the following activities in the coming weeks:

- Retaining walls excavation, blockwork and concrete pours
- Foundation works (platforms, footbridge and lift shafts)
- Platform raising and extension activities
- Footbridge and staircase fabrication (off-site)
- Ongoing North Road carpark expansion works.

Out of hours works - planned track closures: 6am Saturday 15 until 10pm Sunday 16 June (around-the-clock) - platform works, crane lift

8pm Friday 28 June until 6am Monday 1 July (around-the-clock) - large crane lift, footbridge installation



### **Construction impacts**

During construction, localised impacts may include:

- station precinct and North Road carpark closed and reduced customer parking in Sibley Road carpark
- cross-corridor pedestrian access via level crossing
- local traffic management for safety •
- increased vehicle movements near works
- noise associated with construction activity.

Normal working hours are 6am to 6pm, Monday to Saturday. Prior notification will be provided for after hours activities (nights, Sundays or public holidays). Thank you for your patience and cooperation as we build you a better Lindum station.

#### Planning your travel

With Lindum station currently closed, shuttle bus route 229 operates between Lindum and Wynnum North stations, including a stop at Iona College.
