## Lindum station

4:30am, Monday 3 February 2025



### What?

Queensland Rail's contractor has rescheduled concrete activities to commence earlier than planned on Monday 3 February.

Due to current weather conditions, this change is necessary to maintain the concrete temperature for the duration of the pour.

We apologise for this late scheduling change.



### When?

Earlier than scheduled morning (out of hours) works on:

- Monday 3 February, from 4:30am.



### Where?

Concrete pumping activities in the vicinity of the new station building (Sibley Road carpark).

Concrete will be delivered to site via Sibley Road.

Traffic management may be in operation on local streets to assist safe access to the work site.

Movement of concrete pumping trucks and vehicles with flashing lights and reversing beepers



Operation of concrete pumps, machinery and powered tools



Out of hours (early morning) works



Traffic management



Lighting towers at night
