What?

Queensland Rail will receive an early morning delivery of a large crane to Lindum station in preparation for the installation of the new footbridge's final staircase.



When?

Early morning activities, including the arrival of a large crane to site, will occur from **5:30am Tuesday 29 October 2024**.

Due to the size of the crane and the anticipated impact to the road network, this delivery can only be undertaken out of regular working hours.

Crane operation to install the staircase on platform 1 will be undertaken during regular working hours (day shift).

We apologise for the late notice of the scheduling of the crane's arrival.



Where?

The large crane and accompanying trucks will drive into site and be situated in the station's North Road carpark and rail property, with access via North Road.



Impacts



Arrival of a large crane - trucks and vehicles with flashing lights and reversing beepers



After hours activities (early morning)



Traffic control for safety



Truck and crane arrival - vehicle movements and personnel on-site



Lighting towers at night
