

Morningside station accessibility upgrade



PROJECT UPDATE – APRIL 2025

The Morningside station accessibility upgrade is part of Queensland Rail's program to make our stations accessible for everyone.

Since the station reopened in late 2024, further progress has been made towards finalising the station upgrade.

Recent works completed include:

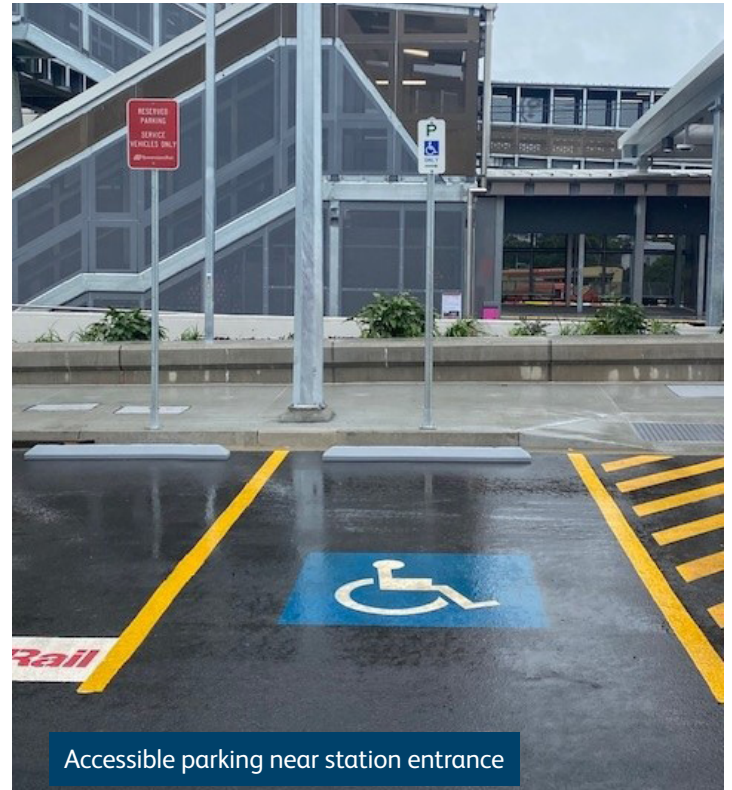
- the lift between Wynnum Road and the footbridge became operational
- removal of the old, non-compliant steel stairs and footbridge
- continuation of station landscaping
- partial removal of contractor site office from the northern end of the park 'n' ride
- kiss 'n' ride, accessible and motorcycle parking, and park 'n' ride area nearest the station entrance opened.

Ongoing works

Some of the remaining upgrade activities include:

- installing the winning Station Accessibility Upgrade Photography Competition artwork
- completion and fitout of the bicycle storage facility
- final landscaping
- upgrade of lighting and CCTV services in the southern end of the park 'n' ride.
