

Morningside station accessibility upgrade



PROJECT UPDATE – JANUARY 2025

The Morningside station accessibility upgrade is part of Queensland Rail's ongoing investment to upgrade stations to make them accessible for everyone.

Queensland Rail is pleased to advise that Morningside station is now open.

While trains are now stopping at the station, construction on additional upgrade features and finishing touches are continuing into early 2025.

When complete, the station will be more accessible and easier for customers and the community to travel on our network.

The new, modern station will help people in wheelchairs, parents with prams and those travelling with luggage or who are injured, use the station with ease.

Upcoming works

Morningside station is accessible for all customers from Waminda Street via a new footbridge with lift and stair access to both fully raised platforms.

Customers and the local community can expect to see the following works progress in the coming weeks:

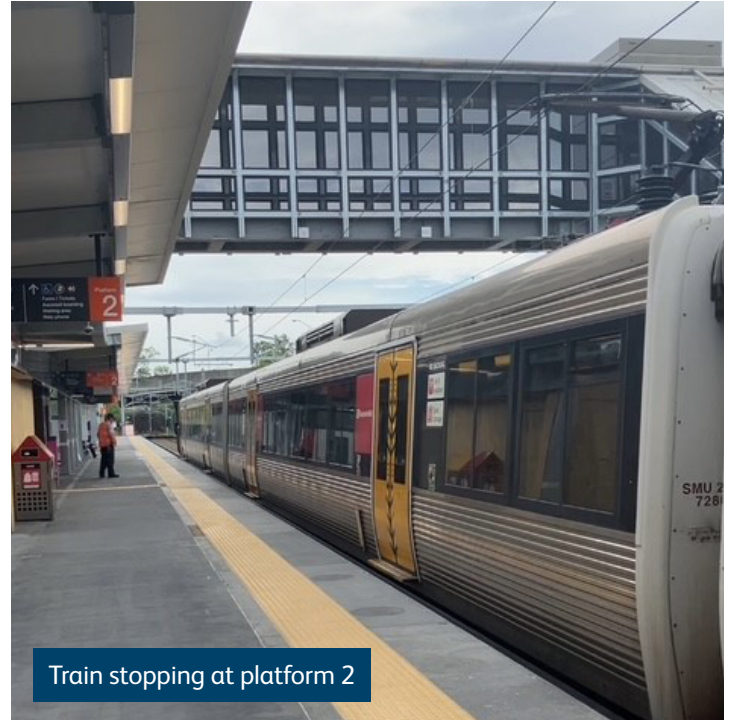
- completion of the Wynnum Road entry stairs and footbridge section
- completion of the kiss 'n' ride drop off zone in the Waminda Street carpark
- removal of the old footbridge.

Ongoing works

- fitout and commissioning of the Wynnum Road entry lift to the station footbridge
- completion of the Waminda Street park 'n' ride, which will remain partially closed to the public in the meantime
- completion of accessible parking bays, dedicated staff parking and motorcycle parking
- build and fitout of bike storage facility on the Wynnum Road side of the station
- landscaping works at the station entries.

Works will generally take place between **6am and 6pm Monday to Saturday**, unless notified.

Every effort will be made to carry out these works with respect for our neighbours and customers.



Wynnum Road access

Stair access from Wynnum Road to the new footbridge and platforms will be available from late January. The fitout and commissioning of the lift will be completed in early 2025.

If you are unable to use the stairs, please follow the detour via Jack Flynn Memorial Drive or follow the detour map when you use the station.
