PROJECT UPDATE – SEPTEMBER 2024

The Morningside station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment to upgrade stations to make them accessible for everyone.

Project benefits

Morningside station is being upgraded to make it more accessible, and easier for customers and the community to travel on our network.

The new, modern station will help people in wheelchairs, parents with prams and those travelling with luggage or who are injured, use the station with ease.

Construction progress

Work has been progressing on site including:

- installation of the footbridge sections and stairs
- platform concrete pours completed
- services connected from Wynnum Road.

Upcoming works

Customers and the local community can expect to see an increase in activity in the following weeks:

- ongoing civil works
- ongoing upgrade of the station building
- platform shelter fitout
- footbridge fitout.

Works will generally take place between **6am and 6pm Monday to Saturday**, unless notified.


Every effort will be made to carry out these works with respect for our neighbours and customers.
