The Morningside station accessibility upgrade is part of Queensland Rail's ongoing investment to upgrade stations to make them accessible for everyone.



Project benefits

Morningside station is being upgraded to make it more accessible, and easier for customers and the community to travel on our network. The new, modern station will help people in wheelchairs, parents with prams and those travelling with luggage or who are injured to access our trains with ease.



Construction progress

Major construction works have been progressing well at Morningside, with the major infrastructure components now installed.

Recent works completed include:

- ✓ installation of the footbridge sections and stairs
- ✓ ongoing civil works
- ✓ upgrade of the station building
- ✓ platform concrete pouring
- ✓ installation of platform structural steel.

Upcoming works

There are planned weekend closures of the inner city and Cleveland lines in November. These closures will allow the project team to work around the clock and make good progress while trains are not running on the network. Weekend works will occur on Saturday 9 and Sunday 10, and Saturday 23 and Sunday 24 November 2024.

Some of the activities planned include:

- commissioning of signaling infrastructure
- fit out of platform shelters
- installation of platform tactiles
- installation of cabling for electrical services.

All other works will generally take place between 6am and 6pm Monday to Saturday, unless notified. Every effort will be made to carry out these works with respect for our neighbours and customers.

Alternative transport

Shuttle bus 237 continues to operate between Morningside and Cannon Hill stations to keep customers moving during the station upgrade.
