

Works notification

Morningside



Why?

Queensland Rail will carry out weekend works at Morningside station as part of the station accessibility upgrade, during planned closures of the Cleveland line.

Works on 22 and 23 February:

- Removal of the old footbridge
 - » cranes will be located in the Waminda Street carpark and Wynnum Road access to remove the old footbridge
 - » excavators will be used to demolish bridge footings and redundant structures
- Carpark and footbridge works.

Temporary lane closures will be required throughout the weekend on Waminda Street and Wynnum Road to facilitate the safe movement of a crane and trucks.

Please follow the instruction of traffic control.

Works on 1 and 2 March:

- Overhead line infrastructure works.

For the safety of the community, the station footbridge and carpark will be closed over both weekends. A pedestrian detour is available via Jack Flynn Memorial Drive.

When?

Works will take place from **6am to 6pm each day** on:

- Saturday 22 and Sunday 23 February
- Saturday 1 and Sunday 2 March.

Where?

Works will be occurring at Morningside station, within the station precinct, on the platform, footbridge, stairs and carpark.
