Purchase Street, Banyo



What?

Queensland Rail's contractor will undertake early morning concrete pumping activities as part of the Banyo station accessibility upgrade.

A concrete pumping truck will be situated in Purchase Street and within the rail corridor to facilitate concrete works at the northern end of platform 2.



When?

Activities will commence from 3am and continue throughout the day on Friday 21 February.



Where?

Concrete activities off Purchase Street (on the pedestrian ramp to the station, which is currently closed).

Concrete deliveries to site will be via local streets.

A lane closure with traffic management will be in operation on Purchase Street for safety. Please follow the direction of traffic controllers.

Access to private properties will be maintained. The pedestrian path along the footpath will be maintained.

Movement of concrete pumping trucks and vehicles with flashing lights and reversing beepers



Early morning works, commencing at 3am



Operation of concrete pumps, machinery and powered tools



Lane closure and traffic management
