Position Purpose

To clean, service and maintain track lubricators, associated assets to deliver safe, cost effective and timely services on behalf of Queensland Rail.

Position Responsibilities

1. Maintain, clean and service rail lubricators to applicable standards and report on the condition and effectiveness of the lubricators.
2. Ensure all work is carried out in accordance with requirements of Queensland Rail Integrated Management System Business and Divisional Instructions to control and minimise loss to people, property, process and environment within their section of Queensland Rail.
3. Ensure safe working practices are adhered to and relevant work standards are met in accordance with Queensland Rail policies, procedures, and legislative requirements.
4. Ensure all work is carried out in accordance with the Safety Management System.
5. Participate in Quality Improvement activities and contribute to the development of new work practices.
6. Work within the guidelines of Queensland Rail Employee Management System.
7. Undertake other duties as directed by your Supervisor or other competent person.

Additional Factors

The appointee will be required to :-

- Comply with Queensland Rail's Code of Conduct;
- Observe all legal and safety obligations of the organisation;
- Travel and work at any location within the Manager's area of control;
- Camp out as required;

- Operate in a semi autonomous manner with broad direction being given by their immediate Supervisor;

- Travel and work outdoors in and around track equipment and structures;
- Work outside normal hours as required including shiftwork;
- Travel and work under difficult and trying conditions on flood repair and other emergency work.
