Monitor and maintain the integrity of the high voltage traction electrical supply system with particular regard to safe operation, identifying faults and irregularities and co-ordinating fault correction work.

Position Responsibilities

- Maintain the diagrams and procedures as well as the control room log accurately and write reports and enter appropriate information into the computer systems.
- Monitor all systems for the optimal usage of the Overhead Traction system.
