- Develop, facilitate, coordinate and implement safety documents including standards, specifications, safety related documents and instructions in accordance with internal policies and procedures.
- 4. Provide advice and assistance to stakeholders and customers on how to meet their rail safety obligations as set out in the Safety and Environment Management System and the Rail Safety National Law.
- Participate in review of operational performance, the conduct of systems audits and audits of compliance with Safety and Environment Management System requirements.
- Prepare and review safety cases, change management plans, change requests and other safety documentation and where necessary make suitable recommendations for adoption at the appropriate level of

management to ensure safety risks are being appropriately managed.

- 7. Assist and/or facilitate various forums where rail safety issues are discussed and agreed for remedial action.
- 8. Achieve the Queensland Rail, Rail Safety business targets, objectives, performance measures, safety responsibilities and continually seek to implement business performance improvement initiatives.
