3. Conduct and implement Risk Management and value engineering activities throughout the project life cycle, conducting consultations with community groups, Unions, Statutory Authorities, Construction Disciplines and other stakeholders in relation to the project.
4. Monitor and manage the implementation of project activities in relation to progress against program and budget, cash flow, work quality and track possession utilisation.
5. Develop and implement project reporting to Senior Management and stakeholders on project progress, with emphasis on actual and potential variations to cost, time and quality.
6. Finalise project activities, including quality and scope sign-offs, closure of project financial systems, project audits and review preparation of final project reports to Senior Management.
7. Maintain close liaison with on-site operations and traffic operations to ensure project objectives and infrastructure standards are achieved.
