5. Ensure that work carried out is in accordance with the Building Code of Australia and all other statutory regulations.
6. Carry out all work in accordance with the requirements of QR Services (QRS) Integrated Management System Business and Divisional Instructions to control and minimise loss to people, property, processes and environment within their section of QRS.

Additional Factors

The appointee will be required to :-

- Comply with Queensland Rail's Code of Conduct;
- Observe all legal and safety obligations of the organisation;
- Work away from home station for extended periods;
- Be "on call" as required;
- Attend further training as required.
