Position Purpose

As a member of Queensland Rail's Major Projects team, provide leadership to ensure effective engineering capability and efficient delivery processes throughout the full project lifecycle including design, renewals, implementation, testing, and commissioning. This role supports the successful delivery of integrated rail infrastructure projects while aligning with broader operational and maintenance activities across Queensland Rail's Network business.

Position Responsibilities

1. Lead the provision of expert track and civil engineering services, advice, and recommendations to deliver projects against defined Key Result Areas (KRAs), considering scope, quality, safety, budget, and time constraints to achieve strong commercial outcomes.
2. Maximise commercial value for Queensland Rail by coaching and supporting teams to manage stakeholder relationships effectively and communicate with impact.
3. Lead and mentor individuals and teams to drive business improvements, technology innovation, and commercial advantage across engineering delivery.
4. Ensure project teams demonstrate professional integrity and sound business practices in the delivery of track and civil engineering products that meet operational requirements and contribute to commercial success.
5. Provide professional engineering guidance for track and civil works, and oversee team compliance with professional standards and the Quality Management System to ensure consistent, safe, and regulation-compliant outputs.
6. Build and maintain strong relationships with internal and external stakeholders to support effective engineering strategies, governance

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procedures, and capability development.

7. Promote and contribute to the achievement of project objectives and performance targets, delivering high levels of customer service to both internal and external stakeholders through collaboration and teamwork.
8. Collaborate with key stakeholders to obtain expert advice and guidance on track and civil engineering initiatives, ensuring optimal support for project delivery.
9. Drive achievement of project targets, safety responsibilities, and performance measures, while continuously seeking opportunities for business performance improvement.
