## Position Purpose

Lead and manage the successful delivery of the Clapham Yard & Yerongpilly Junction Track Construction program of work for the Rail Integration and Systems (RIS) ALLIANCE for the Cross-River Rail (CRR) Project, in a manner consistent with industry best practice and standards and that satisfies Queensland Rail and CRR Delivery Authority (CRRDA) while achieving all the project objectives, targets, performance measures and safety responsibilities.

## Position Responsibilities

1. Develop project plans, including time programs, cost plans and cash flows in line with the approved scope and budget for the project in conjunction with all stakeholders.
2. Support the development of project management practices and administration of the trackconstruction activities to ensure it is executed to the satisfaction of the client and in accordance with agreed specifications, terms and to QR requirements.
3. Manage when required, design and construction disciplines across whole of project to deliver complex track packages.
4. Ensure multi-disciplinary interfaces are managed, including internal delivery, outsourced work, delivery partners, service authorities and government agencies, to meet RIS Alliance program requirements.
5. Undertake negotiations and manage consultations and communications with clients, external bodies as directed by the Clapham Yard Construction Manager.
6. Provide reporting on program status and outcomes to meet the diverse range of the business, client and stakeholder requirements, including reporting to Senior Management on program progress, with particular emphasis on actual and potential variations to scope, cost, time and quality.

7. Monitor and manage assurance activities for both project and construction management including the implementation of risk management and value engineering activities across the program of works.
8. Build relationships with Queensland Rail business units, government bodies, external providers and Queensland Rail staff in order to streamline necessary approvals and documentation for capital and operational works projects, negotiate commitments and sign-offs from the client.

3. High level of leadership and management skills in delivering business outcomes within a complex commercial and customer orientated environment.
4. High level interpersonal communication, consultation, negotiation and influencing stakeholder skills to ensure construction program milestones are achieved.
5. Extensive knowledge regarding UNITY SHE Policies, SHE Cultural Framework, The Safety Essentials and the SHE Management System requirements and expectations.
6. High level of skill in interpreting railway standards (railway transport operations; construction; maintenance and safety) to facilitate delivery of large-scale rail infrastructure projects.
7. Knowledge of and willingness to commit to and work within Queensland Rail's Value and Behaviours.
