## **Position Purpose**

Lead Traction Power personnel in the on-site installation, maintenance and repair of overhead traction power equipment to ensure the safe and effective operation of the rail network.

## **Position Responsibilities**

1. Lead the team as directed by the Traction Overhead Line Coordinator in the on site installation, maintenance and repair of the overhead traction power equipment in accordance with predefined work programs to ensure the safe and effective operation of the rail network.
2. Ensure all work is performed in accordance with Workplace Health and Safety (WH&S) requirements and legislative policies including work activities performed by subordinate employees.
3. Implement, coordinate and manage worksite safe working protection in accordance with Queensland Rail Standards.
4. Implement, coordinate and manage environmental protection in accordance with Queensland Rail Standards.
5. Implement, co-ordinate traction system isolation and access in accordance with Queensland Rail Standards.
6. Ensure all work is performed in accordance with technical and operational specifications and standards including work activities performed by subordinate employees.
7. Maintain all records and associated documentation required.
8. Report on actual work performed against the scheduled work program and equipment performance and condition irregularities.
9. Progress the implementation and application of work procedures and practices in pursuit of ensuring continuous quality improvement.



## Additional Factors

The appointee will be required to :-

- Comply with Queensland Rail's Code of Conduct;
- Observe all legal and safety obligations of the organisation;
- Be available for call out/standby duties, overtime and higher grade relief as required;
- Be available to work away from home station and travel as required;
- Undertake further training considered necessary for the effective performance of the duties associated with the position and career development;
- Work in a semi-autonomous manner within broad guidelines;
- Work outside normal working hours when required;
- Attend training courses as required.

2. High knowledge of High Voltage Operating Procedures and safe working practices and principles.
3. High level of skill in the installation, repair and maintenance of overhead traction power equipment to predetermined standards and procedures.
4. High level of knowledge of WH&S Act and relevant Queensland Rail safety policies and procedures.
5. High level of skill in the supervision of staff and work activities.
6. High level of interpersonal, oral and written/digital communication skills.
7. Knowledge of and willingness to commit to and work within Queensland Rail's Values and Behaviours.
