Position Purpose

To provide a service to operators and owners of wagons through efficient and effective preventative maintenance and repairs of wagons and trains.

Position Responsibilities

1. To work effectively and participate in a semi autonomous work team environment to contribute to the effective operation of semi-autonomous work teams by attending to budgeting, training, EMS issues, safety, environmental, general depot operation and depot maintenance issues in accordance with relevant procedures and instructions.
2. To contribute towards continuous improvement in procedures and instructions in order to enhance customer service.
3. To contribute to the reliability and availability through performance of preventative maintenance and repairs to wagons in accordance with relevant procedures and instructions.
4. Assist in derailment and accident situations in order to minimise effect on customers, to minimise the effects of in service rollingstock defects by efficient and timely attendance and repair of rollingstock in the field as required.
5. To ensure accurate data input to the Information and Maintenance Management Systems.
6. Undertake reliability examinations of trains as required.
7. To liaise with Freight Operations Personnel and Rollingstock Defect Co-ordinators on maintenance and repair matters as required.
8. To ensure the efficient organisation and planning of Operational Safety Practices in accordance with AS 4292 by monitoring and reviewing Operational Safety Practices.



Additional Factors

5. Sound knowledge of Safety and Environment practices and procedures.
6. Sound knowledge of Quality Management Principles.
