- 3. Manage the prioritisation, planning and resourcing of all in-scope assurance and commissioning activities being performed by Queensland Rail, aligned with the standards and requirements established by the Major Projects Integration Systems Integration and Assurance team.
- 4. Ensure that all assurance and commissioning strategies, plans, procedures and other documents provided by the TSD Contractor comply with Queensland Rail's standards and requirements, and enable the

- effective assurance and commissioning of the Cross River Rail program.
- 5. Manage the development, production and delivery of documentation suites required for the successful implementation, handover and maintenance in-scope systems to ensure that they are complete, safe and fit for operational use.
- 6. Anticipate and address potentially significant safety, technical and commercial risks associated with the assurance and commissioning of a large-scale program, and provide detailed reporting to executive level stakeholders outlining progress according to agreed deliverables.
- 7. Manage relationships with key stakeholders and strategically influence decision making processes ensuring beneficial outcomes for Queensland Rail and the TSD project, ensuring continuous interface, communication and integration between QR and the CRRDA and key internal and external stakeholders in delivery of key project milestones.
- 8. Work within Queensland Rail's Assurance and Rail Configuration Control frameworks and governance arrangements appropriate for large scale programs to ensure project objectives are achieved in an integrated and transparent matter.
- 9. Create an environment which promotes and values integrity and business-focused engineering practice through leadership and guidance whilst maintaining processes required for value focused engineering.
