4. Maintain an accurate database on the forecast commissioning dates and key milestones of all projects.
5. Monitor, record and report on project performance by comparing actuals against planned criteria.
6. Produce regular reports, advice and feedback to Project Services Management, Queensland Rail Senior Management and clients on the requirements to meet Queensland Rail's works portfolio.
7. Generate performance indicators on the effectiveness of the project management processes in meeting the planned commitments.

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## What is the key selection criteria

1. High level of skill in the planning and scheduling of large multi-disciplinary complex infrastructure projects in an environment where requirements are conflicting, incomplete or changing.

3. Extensive level of knowledge in the use of project management scheduling tools in particular Primavera P6 and Microsoft Project and the use of these to manage schedule, cost, resources and risk.
4. High level of self motivation, interpersonal, negotiation, oral and written communication skills.
5. Extensive level of knowledge of project management principles.
6. Knowledge of and willingness to commit to and work within Queensland Rail's Values and Behaviours.
