Position Purpose

To carry out the installation, maintenance and repair of power systems equipment and report on the performance and condition of the power systems asset to ensure its safe and effective operation.

Position Responsibilities

1. Lead small teams or autonomously, as directed by the Coordinator Power Systems, to install, maintain and repair substation and associated equipment in accordance with predefined work programs.
2. Ensure all work is performed in accordance with Workplace Health and Safety (WH&S) requirements and legislative policies including work activities performed by subordinate employees.
3. Implement, co-ordinate and manage traction system isolation and access in accordance with Queensland Rail Standards.
4. Implement, co-ordinate and manage worksite safe working protection in accordance with Queensland Rail Standards.
5. Ensure all work is performed in accordance with technical and operational specifications and standards including work activities performed by subordinate employees.
6. Maintain all records and associated documentation relating to asset condition, maintenance programs and costing systems.
7. Report on actual work performed against the scheduled work program and equipment performance and condition irregularities.
8. Progress the implementation and application of work procedures and practices in pursuit of ensuring continuous quality improvement.

Additional Factors

- The appointee will be required to :-
- Comply with Queensland Rail's Code of Conduct;
 - Observe all legal and safety obligations of the organisation;

- Be available for call out/standby duties, overtime and higher grade relief as required;
- Be available to work away from home station and travel as required;
- Undertake further training considered necessary for the effective performance of the duties associated with the position and career development;
- Work in a semi-autonomous manner within broad guidelines;
- Work outside normal working hours when required;
- Where qualified, act in the position of Electric Control Operator as required;
- Attend training courses as required.

6. Knowledge of and willingness to commit to and work within Queensland Rail's Values and Behaviours.
