Position Purpose

Position Responsibilities

3. Provide for the day to day operation and be accountable for the continual improvement of service provided to meet customer requirements.
4. Carry out construction and maintenance work in an acceptable tradesperson like manner.
5. Carry out all work in accordance with the requirements of the Network Integrated Management System Business and Divisional Instructions to control and minimise loss to people, property, processes and environment within their section of Network.

- Observe all legal and safety obligations of the organisation;
- Be trained as an endorsee of Queensland Rail Contractors Licence;
- Work away from home station for extended periods;
- Be "on call" as required;
