Position Purpose

To provide interface, coordination and integrated planning of work activities and Rail corridor access with contractors and Queensland Rail's corridor planning team for the delivery of Major Projects. This role will be embedded with the LGC Rail Alliance.

Position Responsibilities

1. Partner with Queensland Rail Stakeholders and external partners, working collaboratively, developing strong professional relationships to provide leadership and expertise in the development and implementation of staging plans that enhance the utilisation of the Queensland Rail SCAS program and minimum disruption to train operation.
2. Liaise with external partner, contractors, Alliance partners, stakeholders and QLD Rail engineering and discipline heads to integrate connection of Major Projects to the Queensland Rail network.
3. Review integrated construction methodologies in Consultation with project team and construction units to plan resources, estimate costs.
4. Conduct and implement risk management and value engineering activities throughout the project life cycle, conducting consultations with Queensland Rail's engineering and Network Services Construction disciplines, external contractors and other stakeholders in relation to the project/program of works.
5. Participate in the development and implementation of construction safety management systems, monitor and manage site activities in accordance to QLD Rail's SEMS requirements.
6. Maintain close liaison with on-site operations, maintenance providers and network operations to ensure project/program objectives and



- infrastructure standards are achieved.
7. Undertake advance inspections and negotiations for staging works to arrange and advise on scopes of work, interface management strategies and integration strategies for construction works.
 8. Ensure industry Best Practice in the management of internal and external industry partners, including safety and Environment legislative requirements are achieved, and ensure quality expectations are met.
