Position Purpose

To provide protection of the interface between the rail corridor operations and adjoining trackside activities which have the potential to impact upon them in accordance with Queensland Rail's Safety Management System and Safeworking procedures.

Position Responsibilities

- 1. Manage the interface between work groups and worksites on or near the track to ensure compliance with Queensland Rail's safety system.
- 2. Apply the Queensland Rail Safety Management System and Safeworking procedures actively with respect to trackside safety.
- 3. Comply with local operating conditions including use of train Notices, toolbox talks and critical safety notices.
- 4. Maintain a working competency of Working in Electrified Territory (WET) and Safely accessing the Rail Corridor (SARC).
- 5. Be able to work proactively and autonomously to ensure compliance to Queensland Rail's standards and policies.
- 6. Perform alternate suitable duties if competent when Protection Officer duties are not available.

Additional Factors

The appointee will be required to :-

- Comply with Queensland Rail's Code of Conduct;
- Observe all legal and safety obligations of the organisation;
- Work outside normal hours including regular overtime as required.

What is the key selection criteria

- 1. High level of interpersonal, communication and people management skills.
- 2. Substantial knowledge of Queensland Rail's trackside safety standards



and Queensland Rail's Rules and Procedures.

- 3. Sound knowledge of operational procedures including train notices and overhead safety, including isolation protection procedures.
- 4. Sound knowledge of Workplace Health and Safety Legislation, Environmental Protection Policies and their implications for Queensland Rail.
- Sound knowledge of Queensland Rail Operating Environment maintenance and construction activities and their potential to impact on the rail operations.
- 6. Knowledge of and willingness to commit to and work within Queensland Rail's Values and Behaviours.
