As the Asset Manager, provide senior leadership in the application of asset management, asset maintenance and supply chain management in a multi-disciplinary, geographically dispersed Asset Intensive business.

Position Responsibilities

1. Lead the definition of asset objectives that ensure the safe and reliable provisioning of customer centric asset service, through formulation of asset strategies, investment plans and maintenance plans, in a dynamic integrated passenger and freight railway.
2. Influence and negotiate with key internal and external stakeholders to ensure the management of asset risk is financially sustainable through capital funding and operational sustainment strategies and plans.
3. Manage and coordinate the response to emergency situations (e.g., derailments, incidents, natural disasters or near misses) within the geographic/corridor to ensure disruptions and impediments to the network are minimised.
4. Lead large operational and multi-disciplinary teams to achieve a highly engaged, productive workforce underpinned by a safety culture and commitment to drive continued business improvements to deliver safe and compliant assets that contribute to Queensland Rail's service excellence, customer satisfaction, revenue and profit.
5. Represent Queensland Rail as a senior management representative with relevant government bodies, industry associations and other stakeholder groups to influence the direction of the industry to support Queensland Rail and network projects business strategies.
6. Manage the financial and budgetary obligations of the department ensuring all capital and operational expenditure and revenue needs are met in accordance with business requirements.

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7. Provide strategic direction and drive all discipline unit business targets, objectives, performance measures, safety responsibilities, assurance and implement business performance initiatives across internal and external works.
8. Build and maintain collaborative and constructive relationships with customers, stakeholders, suppliers, union representatives and the community to facilitate a positive end-to-end customer experience as well as improving the delivery of maintenance of the Regional network infrastructure.
