- 5. Represent Queensland Rail as a senior management representative with relevant government bodies, industry associations and other stakeholder groups to influence the direction of the industry to support Queensland Rail and network projects business strategies.
- Manage the financial and budgetary obligations of the department ensuring all capital and operational expenditure and revenue needs are met in accordance with business requirements.
