6. Participate in quality improvement activities and contribute to the development of new work practices.
7. Work within the guidelines of Queensland Rail's Employee Management System.

Additional Factors

The appointee will be required to :-
- Comply with Queensland Rail's Code of Conduct;
- Observe all legal and safety obligations of the organisation;
- Travel and work outdoors in and around track equipment and

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- structures;
- Attend further training as required;
- Work outside normal hours as required including shift work;
- Travel and work at any location within the Infrastructure Manager's area of control;
- Travel and work under difficult and trying conditions on flood repair and other emergency work.
