Position Purpose

- To support the management and safety of rail operational interfaces by:-
- Advising on interface requirements for access enquiries, connection agreements and facilities licences;
 - Assessing Operator's operating and/or test plans and authorising services for operation on Queensland Rail Network tracks;
 - Advising on and facilitating risk management;
 - Advising on business requirements for management of the rail infrastructure and its operational interfaces.

Position Responsibilities

1. Provide business advice on and assess interface requirements for access enquiries, connection agreements and facilities licences.
2. Assess Operator's operating and/or test plans, and recommend authorisation of services for operation on the Queensland Rail network.
3. Prepare and issue Train Route Acceptances and Authorities to Travel for proposed operations on the Queensland Rail network.
4. Liaise with and provide advice to operators, other rail managers, access seekers/holders and other Queensland Rail divisions regarding compliance/non-compliance with interface standards to provide for safe railway operations.
5. Support joint interface risk assessments for access agreements, connection agreements and facilities licences.
6. Provide business advice and assistance to other Queensland Rail divisions in relation to access agreements, connection agreements and facilities licences.
7. Monitor railway operations on the Queensland Rail network and report on interface incidents and non compliances.
8. Research and advise on developments in railway operations, interface

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standards and access regimes to promote the continuous improvement of interface standards.

Additional Factors

The appointee will be required to :-

- Comply with Queensland Rail's Code of Conduct;
- Observe all legal and safety obligations of the organisation;
- Work in a flexible manner with a team approach.

What is the key selection criteria

1. High level knowledge of railway operations, rail infrastructure, the interfaces between rail infrastructure and rollingstock and the requirements for safe rail transport.
2. High level of skill in applying the requirements for safe rail transport in determining conditions of travel for the safe rail movement of rollingstock.
3. High level of skill in applying the principles of risk management.
4. High analytical and business-focussed skills in a multi-disciplinary environment.
5. High interpersonal, negotiation, communication and consultation skills whilst working in a flexible manner with a team approach.
6. Knowledge of and willingness to commit to and work within Queensland Rail's Values and Behaviours.
