Position Purpose

In addition to performing the duties of a Locomotive Driver, a Tutor Driver will participate in the development of training programmes, provide practical Tuition to Regional TSD Traincrew within a competency based framework and perform valid assessments of competency to ensure efficient and safe train operations.

Position Responsibilities

1. Competently drive all forms of traction operated in the depot in accordance with Queensland Rail's safety and operational standards and procedures.
2. Plan and effectively implement competency based tuition and assessment for Regional Traincrew in order to ensure knowledge and skills are developed, applied, maintained and assessed in accordance with accreditation and legislative requirements.
3. Provide Regional Traincrew with mentoring, coaching and support in train management, procedures and route competence to the required standards.
4. Provide subject matter expertise in the developments of training materials and assessment. Prepare, maintain and evaluate training and assessment materials, learning documents, logbooks as required.
5. Perform valid and fair assessments of personnel and utilise a range of upskilling methods to ensure competence is maintained.
6. Perform administrative duties including maintenance of required files and depot training records.
7. Maintain professional development of requirements of Training and Assessment Practice.

Additional Factors

The appointee will be required to :-

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- Comply with Queensland Rail's Code of Conduct;
- Observe all legal and safety obligations of the organisation;
- Comply with Queensland Rail's Traincrew Enterprise Agreement;
- Possess a level of health and mental/physical fitness which complies with the requirements of the National Standard for Health Assessment of Rail Safety Workers;
- Travel intrastate as required;
- Attend further training as required.
